Reteag is known from documents since 1283.

It lies between Transylvanian Field and Somesan Plateau.

Reteag is crossed by European Cluj-Dej-Beclean-Bistrița-Suceava.

It is a little net of three villages Reteag-Batza-Poieni belonging to the county Bistrita-Nasaud (Romania, Europe). It has 2791 citizens including: 1582 Romanians, 419 Hungarians, 787 Roma people, 1 Serbian, 1 Turkish and a religious structure as it follows:

2125 Orthodox, 36 Romano-Catholic, 391 Protestant, 75 Greek Catholic (United with Rome), 121 Penticostals, 8 other religions. There is a great desire of developing and modernisation.

Unfortunately it is a region with less economical resources, thus little chances of professional development. We look for any good investments that could help this region.
